Substantial Completion (2/24/2020) - 190 days of 270 days used = 70.4% used.
Final Completion (5/24/2020) = 190 days of 360 days used – 53.8%.
Water tower painting is 90% complete 12/18/2019.
Telemetry for new tank will take at least one week once it has begun.
Tank will then be pressure tested.
